THE MATURING OF PANUN KASHMIR

1. Convert the movement into a political party

- -- Constitution and by-laws
- -- Registration with the Election Commission
- -- Elected national office

2. Take the message to the masses

- -- Symposia and press conferences
- -- Special publications
- -- Newspaper

3. Prepare a winning political strategy

- -- Alliances within J&K (Ladakhis/ Dogras/ Muslims)
- -- Alliances with Indian political parties (BJP/ JP/ etc.)
- -- Continue dialogue within the KP community
- -- Identify "Lead Negotiator" with the central government and KM's
- -- Develop political white papers that: (a) Define the political position of PK, (b) address the concerns of the alliance partners and (c) provide political benefits to those partners

4. Implement a global strategy for success

- -- Importance of global strategy driven by Kashmir being an international issue
- -- Effective communications with US/UK organizations
- -- Establish single international political position
- -- US/UK political advocacy consistent with the international position
- -- Core political position supplemented by regional nuances to address: (a) relationship with the Indian Embassy/ officials, (b) relationship with the local Indian community and (c) utilization of influence from local legislative bodies and the media
